140m2 potholes addressed in January 2024 by HCRDA

With no action in sight by eThekwini Municipality or

KZN Department of Transport to the region's crumbling roads, HCRDA has done what it can to address the worst potholes in the region.



Approximately 140m2 potholes on Mr385 and R103 were cut and filled in January in the vicinity of these areas.

<u>Hammarsdale: Mr385:</u> Sterkspruit bridge, Rainbow Chickens P2 entrance, PreCool, Glodina, Rear of Keystone Park, Opposite PEP, near to on ramp

<u>Cato Ridge: 1000 Hills Street and R103:</u> Inchanga station, Inchanga station bridge, Harrison Flats, Astron Energy
